259 Prospect St., Plainfield: Additional Buildings

In addition to the main house, 259 Prospect Street includes a guest suite, oversized two-car garage, workshop, potting shed with attached equipment storage, and a beautiful one-room studio or retreat building.

The Guest Suite



Across from the main house, the guest suite, above left, has cedar and copper exterior trim. Inside you'll find a spacious bedroom and bath with shower. Baseboard heat warms the suite and an LG mini-split keeps it cool in warmer months. The other side of the structure has two large garage spaces with room for extra storage.

Studio/Retreat



The studio, a short walk down a lovely path away from the main house, was built with timber-frame construction and fieldstone that blends into the old stone walls prevalent throughout the property. There is a slate radiant heated floor, and a threshold made of Ashfield stone "Crow's Foot."

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The Potting Shed/Machine Shed



It's almost too pretty to use! The heated end space of this copper-clad multi-use outbuilding with views to the forest and Bartlett Brook is finished inside with aromatic cedar and a slate floor. The other portion of the building is unheated and used for property equipment storage.

Carport/Workshop



A carport links the main house with a large workshop building with clerestory-style buildings. The workshop has a space heater and exhaust fan.
